A burger and bourbon are part of a great meal you can feel good about. It starts with corn.

GOOD FOR THE SOIL

In Indiana, about 25% of corn is grown using no-till farming, which reduces soil erosion and the release of carbon.



CORN = BOURBON

Some of that corn gets sent to the over 40 local distilleries to become bourbon. To be considered bourbon, it must be made in United States and least 51% corn.



CORN FED CATTLE

The grain left over from the bourbon making process is sent to local farmers to help feed the nearly 900,000 beef cattle raised annually in Indiana.
