

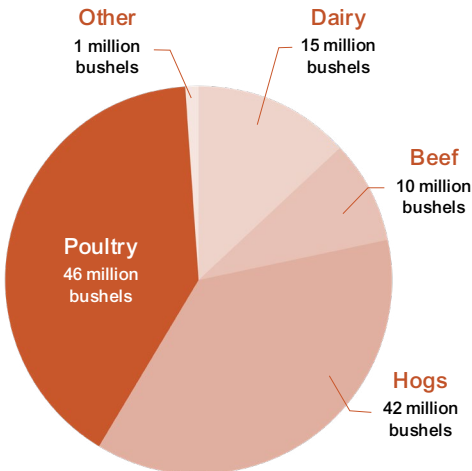


FARMERS DELIVER VALUE THROUGH SUPPORTING LIVESTOCK AND EXPORTS OF MEAT AND POULTRY

Agriculture is linked locally and globally. Corn and soybeans make up the majority of feed for livestock and poultry. The state's thriving poultry industry strengthens the state's corn and soybean industries, all of which contribute back to Indiana's economy.

OF THE CORN FED IN THE STATE IN 2021, BELOW IS A BREAKDOWN OF SPECIES FED.

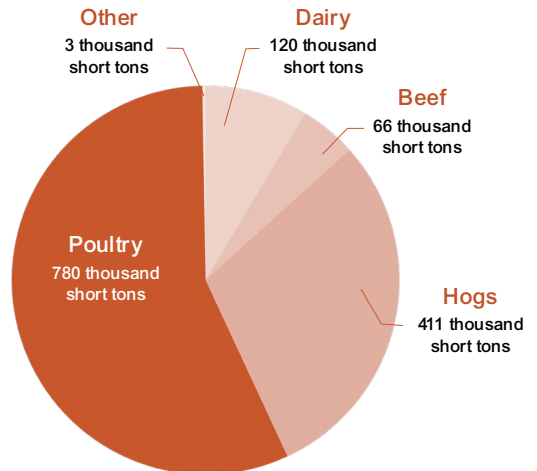
Total corn fed in state: 114 million bushels

BEEF, PORK AND THEIR EXPORTS BOOST INDIANA'S ECONOMY

Both beef and pork production provide strong local markets for Indiana's corn and soybean industry. Local feed customers offer a value-add for crop farmers while producing meat to be consumed in Indiana, the U.S. and in many other countries. Corn and soybean farmers, through the U.S. Meat Export Federation (USMEF), invest in meat export programs.

- In 2021, U.S. beef and pork exports used **36.5 million bushels** of IN corn. Corn revenue back to Indiana generated by pork exports totaled \$200 million. U.S. beef and pork exports contributed \$128.70 per Indiana corn acre.
- In 2021, U.S. pork exports used **7.5 million bushels** of IN soybean meal. Soybean revenue back to Indiana generated by pork exports totaled \$98.6 million. Pork exports contributed \$1.65 per soybean bushel value.
- Beef and pork exports also used about **3.4 million tons** of dried distillers grains with solubles (DDGS) in 2021.¹

INDIANA POULTRY PROVIDES THE PERFECT PLACE FOR CORN AND SOY

Corn and soybean farmers, through the USA Poultry & Egg Export Council (USAPEEC), invest in poultry and egg export programs.

- In 2021, Indiana's poultry and egg production sectors used **46 million bushels** of soybeans (13.7% of total production).
- In 2021, **3.7 million soybean bushels** from Indiana were exported through chicken, turkey, duck and eggs, of which approximately 38.7% were for turkey meat exports, 42.3% were for chicken and duck meat exports and 19% were for egg exports.
- In 2021, Indiana's poultry and egg exports translated into **7.2 million corn bushels**, of which approximately 44.2% were turkey meat exports, 35.7% were for chicken and duck meat exports, and 20.1% were for egg exports.²
