
FOOD-FFUEL WHERE DO SOYBEANS GO?



SOYBEAN MEAL

ANIMAL FEED IS THE **#1 USE FOR SOYBEAN** MEAL. IT CAN BE FED **TO PIGS, CHICKENS,** COWS, TURKEYS, AND DUCKS.

SOY FLOUR AND PROTEIN **CONCENTRATES**/ **ISOLATES CAN BE USED TO MAKE PROTEIN** SHAKES, BABY FOOD, AND MEAT **ALTERNATIVES.**

OTHER

SOY FLOUR CAN BE USED FOR **INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS LIKE** FIREFIGHTING FOAM, PLYWOOD, AND INK.







SOYBEAN OIL IS USED IN MANY FOODS LIKE **VEGETABLE OIL,** MARGARINE, SALAD DRESSING, SNACK FOODS, AND CANDY.

BIODIESE

SOYBEAN OIL IS ALSO **USED FOR CREATING BIODIESEL, WHICH HELPS POWER TRUCKS, BUSES, AND TRACTORS.**



INDUSTRIAL

THE REST OF THE OIL IS USED **IN EVERYDAY PRODUCTS SUCH AS PLASTICS, PAINTS, AND** CLEANERS.
