WHERE DO SOYBEANS GO?

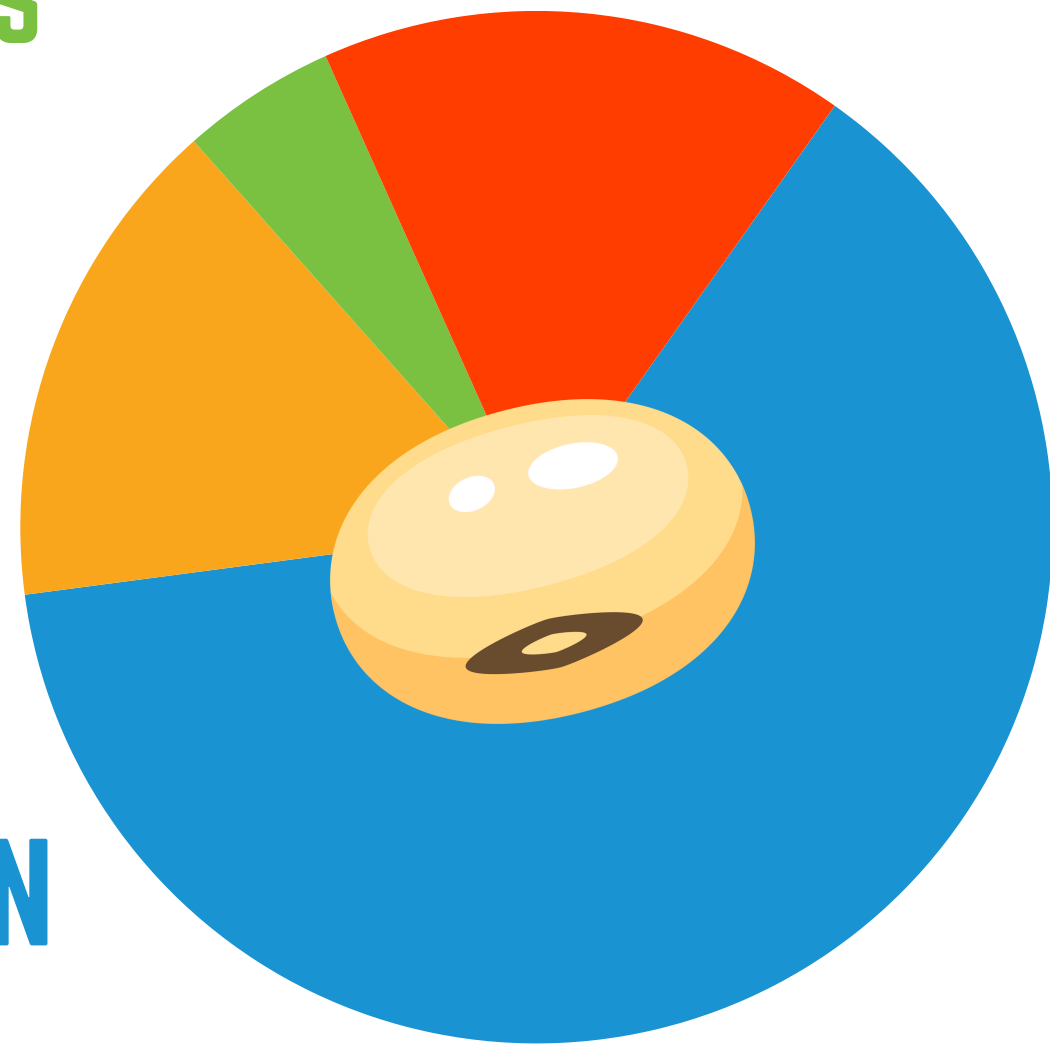

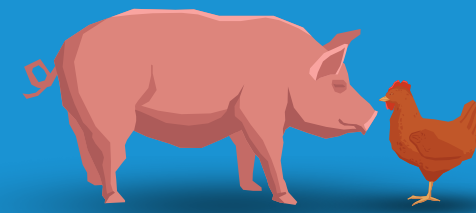

PROTEIN MEAL

SOYBEAN MEAL

ANIMAL FEED IS THE #1 USE FOR SOYBEAN MEAL. IT CAN BE FED TO PIGS, CHICKENS, COWS, TURKEYS, AND DUCKS.



FOOD

SOY FLOUR AND PROTEIN CONCENTRATES/ISOLATES CAN BE USED TO MAKE PROTEIN SHAKES, BABY FOOD, AND MEAT ALTERNATIVES.

OTHER

SOY FLOUR CAN BE USED FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS LIKE FIREFIGHTING FOAM, PLYWOOD, AND INK.



EXPORTS

A PORTION OF THE SOYBEANS IN INDIANA GET PLACED ON BARGES OR TRAINS AND THEN TRANSPORTED TO OTHER COUNTRIES ALL AROUND THE WORLD LIKE MEXICO, COLUMBIA, SOUTH KOREA, EGYPT, CHINA, AND INDONESIA.



OIL

FOOD

SOYBEAN OIL IS USED IN MANY FOODS LIKE VEGETABLE OIL, MARGARINE, SALAD DRESSING, SNACK FOODS, AND CANDY.

BIODIESEL

SOYBEAN OIL IS ALSO USED FOR CREATING BIODIESEL, WHICH HELPS POWER TRUCKS, BUSES, AND TRACTORS.



INDUSTRIAL

THE REST OF THE OIL IS USED IN EVERYDAY PRODUCTS SUCH AS PLASTICS, PAINTS, AND CLEANERS.



WHOLE BEANS



WHOLE SOYBEANS CAN BE MADE INTO FOOD PRODUCTS LIKE TOFU, TEMPEH, AND OTHER MEAT ALTERNATIVES.
