


Exporting Indiana Corn through U.S. Beef & Pork

In 2024, the market value of beef and pork exports to

Indiana Corn = \$150.81 million


(corn consumed by beef and pork exports at average corn price) 35.32 million bushels x \$4.27 per bushel





Indiana DDGS = \$40.03 million

(corn consumed by beef and pork exports at average DDGS price) 231,964 tons x \$172.56 per ton



14% of bushel value = \$0.59

(based on the previous 3-year average percentage per bushel contributed from 2021-2023 x \$4.27/bushel average price in 2024)

3.04 million tons of U.S. DDGS in 2024

30.3% of U.S. pork and pork variety meat production was exported, a new record


Beef export value equated to \$415 per head of fed cattle slaughtered in 2024, the second highest after the 2022 record

(export value divided by 2024 fed cattle slaughter)

Pork export value equated to

\$67 per head

slaughtered in 2024, a new record (export value divided by 2024 commercial hog slaughter)
